Programs Descriptions

Art in the Park (1 to 6 years) This program welcomes parents, caregivers, and children to be inspired by the process of creating masterpieces together, using recyclable materials and loose parts found in nature.

Baby Messy Play (0 to 12 months) This program welcomes parents, caregivers, and babies to engage with their senses to promote early learning and development. Join us in exploring creative messy activities while having fun.

Creative Chefs (2 to 6 years) This program invites parents, caregivers and children to participate in fun and interactive early learning experiences while preparing healthy and nutritious food. Resources on healthy eating and nutrition will be made available for families. **Registration required**

Family Stay & Play (0 to 6 years) Parents, caregivers, and children are welcome to engage in a variety of fun early learning experiences that build positive relationships. A selection of materials will be available for you to play and learn together while providing parents and caregivers with an opportunity to connect with others.

Musical Babies (0 to 12 months) This program welcomes parents, caregivers, and babies to experience music together. Families will gather together and sing songs, learn rhymes, and use a variety of musical instruments, props, and materials.

Nature & Me (0 to 6 years) This program welcomes parents, caregivers, and children outside to explore what nature has to offer. We invite families to discover, appreciate, and respect nature by discovering sights, sounds, smells, and touches along the way. There may be an opportunity to see animals and wildlife in their natural environment.

Playful Math (2 to 6 years) Math is everywhere in our environment! We will use a variety of songs, rhymes, and activities to discover how math can be part of everyday play.



Sing & Sign (0 to 12 months) This program is an introduction to American Sign Language for hearing infants. The session uses songs and games as a tool to include signing in everyday routines. It is an opportunity to bond with your baby and support language development as well as attachment. **Registration required**
