Triple P

Developing Good Bedtime Routines – September 7th, 2023 (1:30 to 3:00) – This discussion topic explores different problems parents commonly face at bedtime and some of the reasons why they happen. The skills children need to get into a good bedtime routine are discussed and parents are introduced to positive parenting strategies to help prevent problems. The approaches to encouraging children to stay in their own bed throughout the night are discussed: the gentle, the gradual, and the direct approach. Parents choose which approach suits them best.

Hassel Free Mealtimes with Children – September 14th, 2023 (1:30 to 3:00) - This discussion topic explores things that influence children's mealtime behavior, setting limits, and teaching children good mealtime habits. Parents will look at ways to increase food variety, be introduced to some positive parenting strategies to help manage mealtimes and develop a personal plan for their family's mealtimes.

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PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Baby Messy Play (0 to 12 months) This program welcomes parents, caregivers and babies to engage with their senses to promote early learning and development. Join us in exploring creative messy activities while having fun.

Family Fun Outdoors (0 to 6 years) This program provides the opportunity to visit local parks and outdoor spaces. Parents, caregivers and children can come and enjoy some fun and interactive outdoor physical activities. Studies show that children who play outdoors are happier and healthier

Family Stay & Play (0 to 6 years) Parents, caregivers, and children are welcome to engage in a variety of fun early learning experiences that build positive relationships. A selection of materials will be available for you to play and learn together while allowing parents and caregivers to connect with others.

Fun with Steam (2 to 6 years) This program invites parents, caregivers, and children to explore STEAM skills and concepts in a group setting. STEAM (science, technology, engineering, art, and math) learning happens every day as children investigate, play, communicate, and try new things.

Journey to Kindergarten (3 to 4 years) -This parenting program is designed to support families with children entering Kindergarten. The goal is to connect participants with community resources and services in York Region and to provide a community space in which to exchange ideas, information, and parenting tools that will ultimately help to establish a solid foundation in all domains of learning and will contribute to positive experiences and outcomes for children.

Musical Babies (0 to 12 months) This program welcomes parents, caregivers, and babies to experience music together. Families will gather and sing songs, learn rhymes, and use a variety of musical instruments, props, and materials.

Parent-Child Mother Goose (0 to 12 months) This program is a group experience for parents and their babies and young children focusing on the pleasure and power of using rhymes, songs and stories together. Parents gain skills and confidence that can enable them to create positive family patterns during their children’s crucial early years. Children benefit from enjoyable, healthy early experiences with language and communication.

Preschool Play to Learn (2 to 6 years) Parents, caregivers and preschoolers are invited to a supportive environment that provides opportunities to discover and engage in social and interactive play to enhance every area of early learning and development.

Playful Math (2 to 6 years) Math is everywhere in our environment! We will use a variety of songs, rhymes, and activities to discover how math can be part of everyday play.

Sing & Sing (0 to 12 months) This program is an introduction to American Sign Language for hearing infants. The session uses songs and games as a tool to include signing in everyday routines. It is an opportunity to bond with your baby and support language development and attachment.

Songs, Rhymes, & Stories (0 to 6 years) This program welcomes parents, caregivers, and children to experience a variety of stories and musical activities. Music brings the community together; families can hear and share songs, rhymes, and stories.
