Programs Descriptions

Family Stay & Play (0 to 6 years) - Parents, caregivers, and children are welcome to engage in a variety of fun early learning experiences that build positive relationships. A selection of materials will be available for you to play and learn together while providing parents and caregivers with an opportunity to connect with others.

Family Yoga (2 to 6 years) - Yoga promotes a sense of well-being in the mind and body through movements that encourage balance, coordination, good posture, and body awareness.

Parents/caregivers will also model how to channel their emotions through the practice of deep breathing and relaxation exercises. Wear comfortable clothing.

Little Artists (2 to 6 years) - Welcome to Little Artists! This program inspires adults to nurture creative kids through easy, open-ended, and fun activities. It's the kind of activity that children will want to do over and over again.
