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## Programs Descriptions

**Family Stay & Play** (0 to 6 years) - Parents, caregivers, and children are welcome to engage in a variety of fun early learning experiences that build positive relationships. A selection of materials will be available for you to play and learn together while providing parents and caregivers with an opportunity to connect with others.

**Family Yoga** (2 to 6 years) - Yoga promotes a sense of well-being in the mind and body through movements that encourage balance, coordination, good posture, and body awareness. Parents/caregivers will also model how to channel their emotions through the practice of deep breathing and relaxation exercises. Wear comfortable clothing.

**Little Artists** (2 to 6 years) - Welcome to Little Artists! This program inspires adults to nurture creative kids through easy, open-ended, and fun activities. It's the kind of activity that children will want to do over and over again.

**Move & Groove** (0 to 6 years) - This program provides an opportunity for parents, caregivers, and their children to engage in active play that supports the development of gross motor skills while having fun. Through a variety of experiences together we will stretch, bend, and move to music to support healthy living.

**Nature & Me** (0 to 6 years) - This program welcomes parents, caregivers, and children outside to explore what nature has to offer. We invite families to discover, appreciate, and respect nature by discovering sights, sounds, smells, and touches along the way. There may be an opportunity to see animals and wildlife in their natural environment.

**Sing & Sign** (0 to 12 months) - his program is an introduction to American Sign Language for hearing infants. The session uses songs and games as a tool to include signing in everyday routines. It is an opportunity to bond with your baby and support language development as well as attachment. **Registration Required**

**Zumbini** (0 to 6 years) - Zumbini is a movement-based program that provides the opportunity for children to experience the sounds and rhythm of the music and movement. Zumbini also encourages parent-child bonding while helping to develop cognitive abilities, motor and social skills, language, and emotional well-being.
