Baby & Me (0 to 12 months) – Parents, caregivers, and babies are invited to join in on conversations and information sharing on healthy child development. This program includes songs, rhymes, and activities, which encourage connections with your baby.

Children as Authors (2 to 6 years) - This program encourages preschoolers to create stories and draw pictures with their parents and caregivers. Each child will have the opportunity to sit in the author's chair and share their own book with the group.
