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


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May 2025 Virtual Programs



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Child and Family Centre

Program Description

Family Stay & Play (0 to 6 years) - Parents, caregivers, and children are welcome to engage in various fun early learning experiences that build positive relationships. A selection of materials will be available for you to play and learn together while allowing parents and caregivers to connect with others.

Fun with STEAM (2 to 6 years) - This program invites parents, caregivers, and children to explore STEAM skills and concepts in a group setting. STEAM (science, technology, engineering, art, and math) learning happens everyday as children investigate, play, communicate, and try new things.

Infant Massage (0 to 12 months) - This program promotes nurturing touch and communication and teaches parents how to massage their babies, read the babies' cues, and help with bonding and attachment. Supporting and encouraging parents to trust their abilities and intuition are part of the process. The International Association of Infant Massage (IAIM) instructors are certified to teach this program. Registration required

Journey to Kindergarten (3 to 4 years) - This program supports families with children about to enter Kindergarten, connecting them to York Region resources, fostering idea exchange and contributing to building a strong foundation for children's learning and positive experiences. Registration Required

Move & Groove (0 to 6 years) - This program provides an opportunity for parents, caregivers, and their children to engage in active play that supports the development of gross motor skills while having fun. Through a variety of experiences together we will stretch, bend, and move to music to support healthy living.

Musical Babies (0 to 12 months) - This program welcomes parents, caregivers, and babies to experience music together. Families will gather and sing songs, learn rhymes, and use a variety of musical instruments, props, and materials.

Parent-Child Mother Goose (0 to 12 months) - his program is a group experience for parents and their babies and young children focusing on the pleasure and power of using rhymes, songs and stories together. Parents gain skills and confidence which can enable them to create positive family patterns during their children's crucial early years. Children benefit from enjoyable, healthy early experiences with language and communication.

Toddler Time (10 to 30 months) - Parents, caregivers and toddlers are welcome to play together and discover the world through their senses. The nurturing environment enhances learning experiences that support healthy child development.

Zumbini (0 to 6 years) - Zumbini is a movement-based program which provides the opportunity for children to experience the sounds and rhythm of the music and movement. Zumbini also encourages parent-child bonding while helping to develop cognitive abilities, motor and social skills, language, and emotional well-being. It is also a fun workout for parents! Strollers' "N' Motion (0 to 12 months) -This program highlights moving, walking, building strength, nurturing a healthy body & mind, and creativity while creating an empowering community for everybody! – Please meet at the centre first

Parenting Programs

Let's Talk - Parenting is not always easy, and it helps to know we are not alone. This program provides time for parents/caregivers to come together to network and share their parenting experiences and challenges. Community partners may also join to offer their expertise. Settle in for an hour just for you!

Triple P Primary Care & Stepping Stones -

Primary care is a private and quick way to get Triple P support that targets the exact parenting problem or issue you are having (e.g., tantrums, fighting, going shopping) and supports skill development e.g., eating independently, toilet training, or staying in bed at night.) You (and your partner if you wish) will meet with a Triple P provider about four times. Registration Required

Stepping Stones is based on Triple P's positive parenting strategies. It helps you manage problem behaviours and developmental issues common in children with disability. It also helps encourage the behaviour you like, cope with stress, develop a close relationship with your child, and teach your child new skills. Registration Required

Virtual Parenting Program
