Program Description

Baby & Me (0 to 12 months) - You and your baby are invited to join us for songs, rhymes, and experiences designed to help you connect with your baby. Enjoy engaging conversations and information sharing on healthy child development. It's a great way to connect with your baby, other families, and educators.

Baby Music & Movement (0 to 12 months) – This program invites you and your baby to enjoy music and movement together. We'll sing songs, play with instruments and materials that help support healthy development while connecting with other families and educators.

Infant Massage (0 to 12 months) - This program promotes nurturing touch and communication and teaches parents how to massage their babies, read their babies' cues, and help with bonding and attachment. Supporting and encouraging parents to trust their abilities and intuition are part of the process. The International Association of Infant Massage (IAIM) instructors are certified to teach this program. **Registration required**

Journey to Kindergarten (3 to 4 years) - This program supports families with children about to enter Kindergarten, connecting them to York Region resources, fostering idea exchange, and contributing to building a strong foundation for children's learning and positive experiences. **Registration Required**

Music & Movement (0 to 6 years) - This program invites you and your child(ren) to enjoy music and movement together. We'll sing songs, play with instruments and materials that help support healthy development while connecting with other families and educators.

Parent-Child Mother Goose (0 to 12 months) - his program is a group experience for parents and their babies and young children, focusing on the pleasure and power of using rhymes, songs, and stories together.
