Virtual Parenting Programs

Let's Talk (0 to 6 years) -Join us for the opportunity to speak with educators and other families. Topics may include child development, available community information, newcomer and prenatal, and postnatal supports. Community partners may also join to offer their expertise.

Stepping Stones Group (0 to 6 years) - This program is for families who have concerns about their child(ren)'s development. Strategies to help you manage challenging behaviours common in children who have developmental concerns will be discussed. Six sessions, which last 2 ½ hours each. Your provider will also call you at home at pre-arranged times to offer support, feedback, and ideas. This program helps encourage behaviour you like, cope with stress, develop a close relationship with your child, and teach your child new skills.
