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Program Description

Baby & Me (0 to 12 months) - You and your baby are invited to join us for songs, rhymes, and experiences designed to help you connect with your baby. Infant Massage (0 to 12 months) - This program promotes nurturing touch and communication. It teaches parents how to massage their baby, read their baby's cues, and helps with bonding and attachment. Certified instructors will support and encourage parents to trust their ability and intuition as part of the process. It's a great way to connect with other families and educators. **Registration required**

Music & Movement (0 to 6 years) - This program invites you and your child(ren) to enjoy music and movement together. We'll sing songs, play with instruments and materials that help support healthy development while connecting with other families and educators.

Parent Child Mother Goose (0 to 12 months) - This program invites you and your baby or young child to a group experience that focuses on the pleasure and power of using rhymes, songs, and stories together. You will be introduced to skills that can enhance your confidence to create positive family patterns during your child's critical early years. Everyone can benefit from enjoyable, healthy experiences with language and communication. It's a great way to connect with other families and educators.

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Program Descriptions

Outdoor Programs

Art in the Park (1 to 6 years) - This program welcomes parents, caregivers, and children to be inspired by the process of creating masterpieces together, using recyclable materials and loose parts found in nature.

Family Walk (0 to 6 years) - This program invites you and your child(ren) to get active and explore the community while promoting a healthy lifestyle. It's a great way to connect with other families and educators.

Parenting Programs

Let's Talk - Parenting is not always easy, and it helps to know we are not alone. This program provides time for parents/caregivers to come together to network and share their parenting experiences and challenges. Community partners may also join to offer their expertise. Settle in for an hour just for you!

Fear-Less - (30 mos to 6 years) - This six-week series of small group sessions is for families who want to learn about strategies to support their child(ren) who may be experiencing anxiety, stress, and worry. Families will receive information on how to set a good example of coping with anxiety, coaching children to become more emotionally resilient, and suggestions for developing their own toolbox of strategies. Families can choose how to support their child(ren) best as they learn to manage their anxiety more effectively.

Virtual Parenting Program

Let's Talk - Parenting is not always easy and it helps to know we are not alone. This program provides time for parents/caregivers to come together to network and share their parenting experiences and challenges. Community partners may also join to offer their expertise.

Stepping Stone Group - This program is for families who have concerns about their child(ren)'s development. Strategies to help you manage challenging behaviours common in children who have developmental concerns will be discussed. Six sessions, which last 2 ½ hours each. Your provider will also call you at home at pre-arranged times to offer support, feedback, and ideas. This program helps encourage behaviour you like, cope with stress, develop a close relationship with your child, and teach your child new skills.
