Program Descriptions

Baby & Me (0 to 12 months) - You and your baby are invited to join us for songs, rhymes, and experiences designed to help you connect with your baby. Enjoy engaging conversations and information sharing on healthy child development. It's a great way to connect with your baby, other families, and educators.

Baby Music & Movement (0 to 12 months) - This program invites you and your baby to enjoy music and movement together. We'll sing songs, play with instruments and materials that help support healthy development while connecting with other families and educators.

Learning Through Nature (2 to 6 years) - Learning Through Nature is a program that focuses on the splendour and beauty of the nature that is all around us. This program aims to promote young children's learning through an awareness and love of nature. We're bringing nature inside, but let's think outside - no box required!

Music & Movement (0 to 6 years) - This program invites you and your child(ren) to enjoy music and movement together. We'll sing songs, play with instruments and materials that help support healthy development while connecting with other families and educators.

Play Learn & Connect (0 to 6 years) - This program invites you and your child(ren) to engage in experiences that promote early learning, social skills, and creativity. Together, you may explore songs, stories, and hands-on activities through interactive play. It's a great way to connect with other families and educators.

Sing and Sign (0 to 12 months) - This program is an introduction to American Sign Language for hearing infants. The session uses songs and games as a tool to include signing in everyday routines. It is an opportunity to bond with your baby and support language development as well as attachment.

Toddler Time (10 to 30 months) - Parents, caregivers, and toddlers are welcome to play together and discover the world through their senses. The nurturing environment enhances learning experiences that support healthy child development.

Virtual Parenting Programs

Let's Talk (0 to 6 years) - Parenting is not always easy, and it helps to know we are not alone. This program provides time for parents/caregivers to come together to network and share their parenting experiences and challenges. Community partners may also join to offer their expertise. Settle in for an hour just for you!

Stepping Stones Group - This program is for families who have concerns about their child(ren)'s development. Strategies to help you manage challenging behaviours common in children who have developmental concerns will be discussed. Six sessions, which last 2 ½ hours each. Your provider will also call you at home at pre-arranged times to offer support, feedback, and ideas. This program helps encourage behaviour you like, cope with stress, develop a close relationship with your child, and teach your child new skills. **Registration required**
