Parent-Child Mother Goose (0 to 12 months) - This program invites you and your baby or young child to a group experience that focuses on the pleasure and power of using rhymes, songs, and stories together. You will be introduced to skills that can enhance your confidence to create positive family patterns during your child's critical early years. Everyone can benefit from enjoyable, healthy experiences with language and communication. It's a great way to connect with other families and educators.

Play Learn & Connect (0 to 6 years) - This program invites you and your child(ren) to engage in experiences that promote early learning, social skills, and creativity. Sing and Sign (0 to 12 months) - This program is an introduction to American Sign Language for hearing infants. The session uses songs and games as a tool to include signing in everyday routines. It is an opportunity to bond with your baby and support language development as well as attachment.
