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Program Descriptions

Infant Massage (0 to 12 months) - This program promotes nurturing touch and communication. It teaches parents how to massage their baby, read their baby's cues, and helps with bonding and attachment. Certified instructors will support and encourage parents to trust their ability and intuition as part of the process. It's a great way to connect with other families and educators.
